

EAST-WEST PHILOSOPHERS' CONFERENCE

12-15 AUGUST 1994

Massey University

Palmerston North

New Zealand

The Australasian Society for Asian and Comparative Philosophy will be convening an international conference at Massey University (12-15 August 1994). We are expecting delegates from Asia, Europe and North America, as well as from Australia and New Zealand. The language of the conference will be English.

CALL FOR PAPERS: A strictly limited number of sessions are still open. Offers of suitable papers are welcome. Presentations should be of around 45 minutes duration in order to allow adequate time for discussion. A brief abstract of approximately 75 words should be supplied in advance.

REGISTRATION: The registration fee is NZ\$75 per person. This must be received by 12 July 1994 to guarantee a place.

ACCOMMODATION: On-campus accommodation is available at NZ\$45.40 per night for bed and breakfast; NZ \$63.50 per night for full board. These are single rooms with shared bathroom facilities in a university student hostel. Alternative accommodation is available, but not on campus. A motel some 30 minutes walk away would cost around NZ \$75, meals extra. Hostel accommodation fees must be fully paid in advance, but are refundable on receipt of at least 24 hours notice. Motel bookings require a deposit of NZ \$75 paid in advance, but this is refundable on receipt of at least 24 hours notice. Accommodation fees must be received by 12 July to guarantee a place.

TIMETABLE: Registration for the Conference will take place from 3 p.m. on 12 August. The first session is scheduled for the evening of 12 August; the final session for the afternoon of 15 August. There will be only three plenary sessions; all other sessions will be scheduled in groups to run concurrently.

CONFERENCE DINNER: A conference dinner is tentatively scheduled for the evening of 14 August if there is sufficient interest. Cost would be approximately NZ \$28 per person, alcohol extra. Expressions of interest are welcomed. (No money need be sent yet.)
